This matter having come before the Mine Safety Review Commission (hereinafter "Commission") upon the Office of Mine Safety & Licensing's motion for default filed on November 22, 2013 regarding Jeremiah Jones and the members of the Commission having reviewed the Complaint filed on August 8, 2013 and making a determination of probable cause in the matter herein, and the Commissioners being sufficiently advised; and,

WHEREAS that pursuant to KRS 13B.080(6):

If a party properly served . . . **fails to attend or participate in a pre-hearing conference, . . . the hearing officer may adjourn the proceedings and issue a default order** granting or denying relief as appropriate, or may conduct the proceedings without the participation of the defaulting party, having due regard for the interests of justice and the orderly and prompt conduct of the proceedings. A default order shall be considered a recommended order and shall be processed as provided in KRS 13B.110.

WHEREAS the respondent has been properly served and notified of the Complaint, the Probable Cause and the motion for default and made no answer or defense or participated in any way; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a Final Order for default is entered against Jeremiah Jones;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this Final Order shall be considered to constitute a "first offense" as that term is defined in 805 KAR 8:010, Section 1(5). Future allegations of separate offenses by Respondent, resulting in an adjudication of guilt by the Commission, shall be deemed "subsequent offenses" as defined by 805 KAR 8:010, Section 1(13);


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED the Respondent Jones underground miner and surface miner **certificates** are **PROBATED** for a period of no less than **one (1) year** from the date of this Order;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Respondent is ineligible for any other or additional certifications for a period of no less than one (1) year from the date of this Order;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to KRS 351.194(8) and KRS 13B.140(1), **an appeal of an order of the Commission must be filed in the Franklin Circuit Court within thirty (30) days of the entry of this Final Order.** The petition shall include the names and addresses of all parties of record in this proceeding and shall include a statement of the grounds upon which review is requested. A copy of this

Final Order shall accompany the petition. Copies of the petition must be served upon the Commission and all parties of record in this proceeding.


